

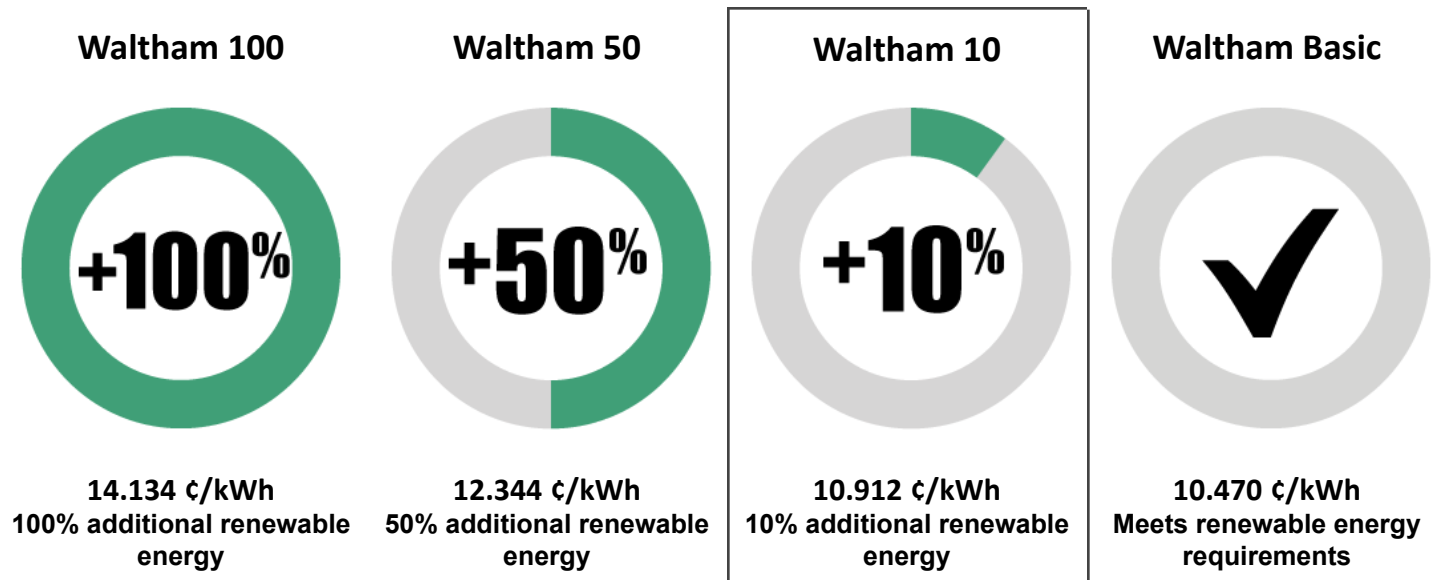


# Waltham Community Electricity

Waltham Community Electricity (WCE) is a City-run program that leverages the electricity use of thousands of residents and businesses in Waltham to provide electricity options, multi-year fixed rates and more renewable electricity. Our City’s program began in May 2021 and will run through December 2023. The program’s default option adds 10% of renewable electricity beyond what’s required by State standards. Most residents and businesses already participate in WCE at the Waltham 10 level, and anyone who receives an electricity bill from Eversource can participate: it doesn’t matter whether you are a renter or an owner.

## WCE Electricity Options

While there is **no guarantee of future savings** (future Eversource rates are not known), we expect the program to be competitive and provide value, especially in terms of the predictability of the electricity rates which are set until December 2023.

## Additional Renewable Energy

All of the additional renewable energy resources are located in New England, certified MA Class I and come primarily from wind, solar and low-impact hydro, provided to the program by the Boston-based non-profit Green Energy Consumers Alliance. The program purchases and retires Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) to substantiate all claims of renewable energy use.
